6 year old Bhanu Charun is a new entrant to the Ashray Akruti family. He hails from a poor family in Warangal. His father runs a small business in his native place, makes a meager income. His mother is a home maker. He has an elder brother who attends regular school. Bhanu was detected with hearing loss at the age of one and half year. This news totally shattered the parents. With no proper facility in the area for a child with disability the parents felt totally helpless, his future seemed absolutely bleak.



It was from one of the friends that his parents heard about Ashray Akruti and approached the school for admission.

Bhanu Charan was enrolled in the Nursery class in June 2014. He stays in the residential facility run by Ashray Akruti.
