Later, he will be given post Cochlear Therapy at Ashray Akruti which would enable him to speak and respond at par with his fellow mates.

It was a great relief for V.Babu from Kadapa who works as daily laborer to get a free Cochlear Implant Surgery for his daughter Subhanbi (3 years old). On 8<sup>th</sup> of Dec 2015, Subhanbi has undergone implants. She will be provided rigorous therapy at Ashray Akruti which help her to listen and talk.

The parents of both Jagdish and Subhanbi expressed their heartfelt gratitude to Ashray Akruti for the fathomless support.

## Ashray Akruti children exhibits science projects at Qualcomm



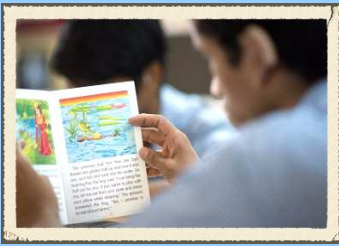

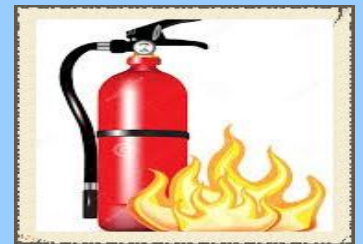
