It was a joyous moment in the lives of K. Subbamma and Mangamma when they received free Hearing Aids from Ashray Akruti. The two senior citizens from St. Anthony's Old Age Home were identified through Ashray Akruti's Mobile Hearing Clinic project which conducts free hearing screening in old age homes. Ankita and Naveen, Audiologists at Ashray Akruti Hearing Clinic fitted Digital Hearing Aids for them. "Many old women like us are living in old age homes without any income. We cannot afford the high cost of hearing aids but Ashray Akruti, by providing free hearing aids is really helping us to hear better" expressed Subbamma.

Community Ear Health Project conducts Ear Screening Camp at Govt. School Sriram Nagar



Free ear health camp was conducted at Sriram Nagar Primary and High School at Sriram Nagar, by the team of Ashray Akruti Community Ear Health Project. Through the eleven days standalone camps at Sriram Nagar School, 458 children were screened and 201 children were given medication. Five children were referred for further hearing evaluation as they were found with foreign bodies in ears and tonsil problems. Dr. Sruthi, Dr. Navshaba, Dr. Venkateshwer and Dr. Dipin Kumar from ENT Department, Gandhi Hospital and Dr. Dwaraka Nath Reddy and Dr. Sai Kumar, ENT Specialists extended their services throughout the camps.

The uniqueness of the Ear Health Care Camp lies in its comprehensive approach where ear health promotion and awareness are given equal importance while curative care is administered. "Ashray Akruti's Community Ear Health Workers are admirable. They stood true to the words of devotion and dedication during the camps. No words are enough to describe their remarkable act of assistance", said L.Padmaja, Head Mistress of Sriram Nagar Primary and High School.

There would be home visits by our community workers for follow up of the medicated children and awareness would be given to parents to sensitize them on ear and hearing care.

Ashray Akruti's Mobile Hearing Clinic conducts hearing screening in Borabanda slum area

Mobile Hearing Clinic kick started it's free hearing screening camp in the slum area in Borabanda. Addressing the immediate hearing care needs of the underserved people in the community, the camp were held in the Urdu Medium School at Borabanda site 3rd slum area on September 7th. 8 PTA (Pure Tone Audiometry) was conducted and 5 were referred for Impedance test.

Commenting on the free hearing screening, Alam, In charge of Urdu Medium School said that "I am very much impressed about the unique and committed approach of Ashray Akruti. In fact my daughter is getting free physiotherapy at Ashray Akruti's Multi Disability Centre at Borabanda. Here at the camp by conducting free screenings, Ashray Akruti has given an opportunity to many underprivileged to get their hearing checked."



Free hearing screening at Old Age Homes

Free hearing screening at Government Old Age Home, Amberpet was conducted by the team of the Mobile Hearing Clinic project. 22 (Pure Tone Audiometry) PTA tests were conducted and among them 5 were referred for Impedance test. 2 senior citizens were referred for hearing aids as per audiologist recommendation.

Hearing screening camp was conducted at Dalita Mahila Old Age Home at Tukaram Gate, Secunderabad and 11 people got their ears screened.
