
BUILDING COMMUNITY AND HEALTH SYSTEM RESILIENCE DURING COVID CRISIS



I am V. Rajanikanth, disabled, and used to do plumbing & electrical work, living in a rental accommodation. My wife Maria Florima earlier worked as a nurse Kim's hospital & we have two children. Before the pandemic outbreak my wife had an accident and her backbone got fractured.

Since then I have stopped going to work and have been taking care of her. She has been undergoing treatment at KIMS Hospital. I did not take the ration for three months when



I was attending at the hospital was totally dependent on the pension given by the government for the disabled. Now, she is discharged and advised to be on complete bed rest for 8 months.
