At Ashray Akruti we affirm our commitment in offering continued services by supporting the most defenseless communities and helping these communities & our employees cope with the realities of COVID-19. Even during these unprecedented and disconcerting times, we have been enhancing the capabilities of our frontline health care team, who are playing a pivotal role in the relief operations & creating awareness among the masses. Ashray Akruti is a non-profit voluntary organization established in 1996 in Hyderabad working in the disability sector and providing access to quality education to children, health care and sustainable livelihoods to persons with disabilities from marginalized sections of Society. Our observations at the grass root level revealed that many had lost their employment, particularly those working in small establishments, while the plight of the daily wage / migrant labourer's was even worse. Majority are suffering from mental health issues, lack of basic food and essential amenities, facing the stigma of an outbreak, lack of communication, all leading to depression.

COVID-19 Relief Impact

While there's a lot of uncertainty, we know that we need to adapt fast to this changing reality. Thus, post mobilization of resources, our Divyangjan and other vulnerable communities are offering safety, protection & prevention measures and creating awareness amongst the deprived community.

Story of Change

Balakrishna, suffered from a neurological problem at age 17. His mother took him to several hospitals for treatment, but all the attempts were futile. He was dejected due to his illness and attempted suicide several times. He and his mother were dependent on his mother's



daily wage earnings and a small government pension. The recent pandemic resulted in his mother being unemployed, and the entire pension was only sufficient for Balakrishna's medical treatment. Most days saw both mother and son go to bed on an empty stomach. "While we were going through this challenging situation and felt totally helpless, Ashray Akruti conducted a relief camp for persons with disabilities. I was fortunate to receive a grocery kit. This has not only provided me food but gave me the hope of survival. Without the support of donors like Tech Mahindra Foundation and Persistent Foundation, there was no way out of starvation for me. My heartfelt gratitude for seeing me through this difficult time," says an emotional Balakrishna. We thank our donors for their generous support in helping us distribute COVID relief kits in the districts of Telangana State and donating money in these trying times to 593 needy parents of hearing-impaired children. Through your donation, we have been able to accomplish multiple approaches to tackle our COVID-19 Relief Service.
