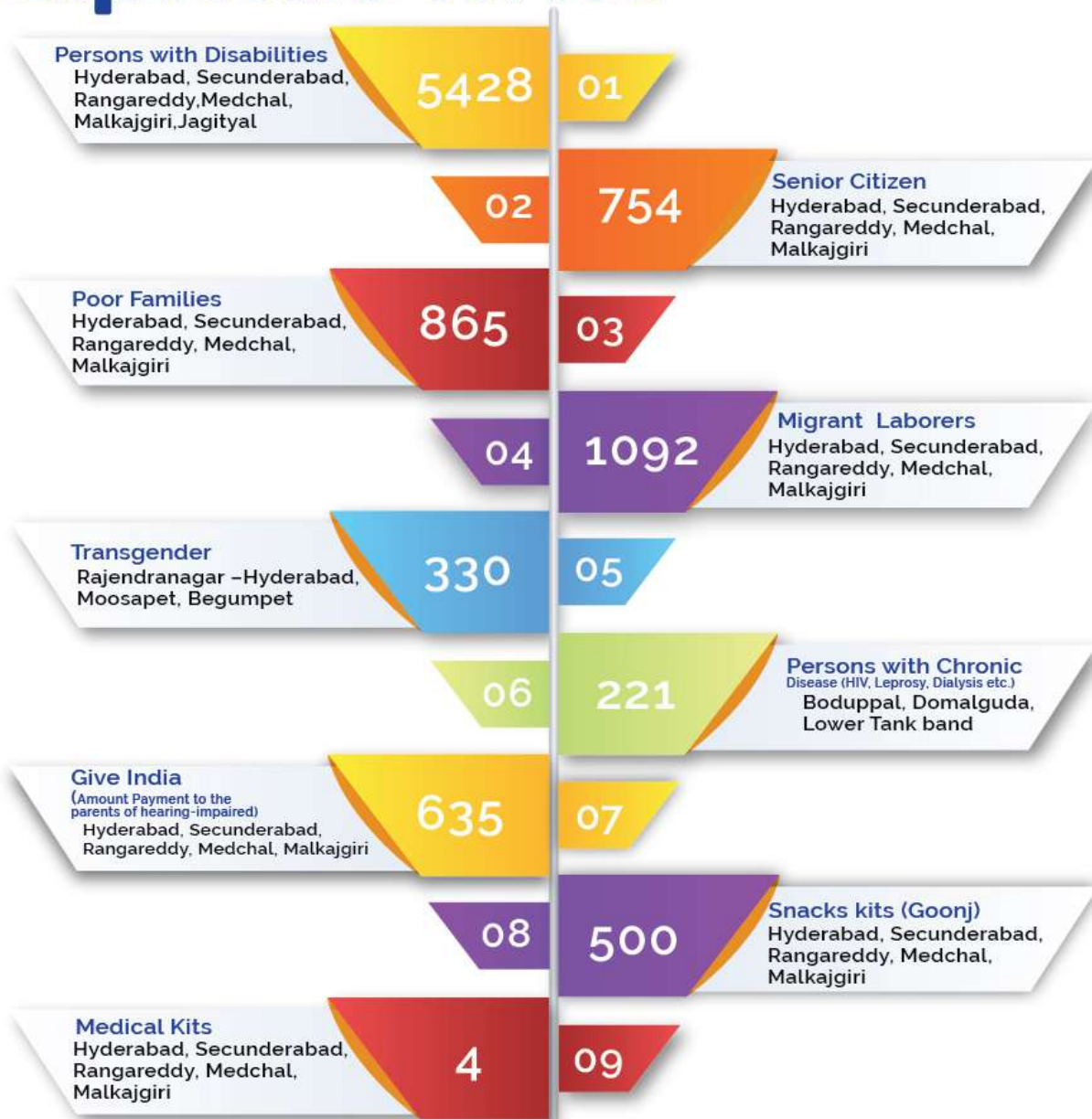

Case History

Addagatla Elias has been suffering with locomotor impairment by birth, with dysfunctional lower limbs can move only with the support of tricycle. He is a bachelor, doesn't have any source of income other than a Disability pension. Past few months, their family has been facing trouble as Elias cannot go out of the home to earn money or to procure essentials, and they were unable to pay the house rent. No one cares about people with disabilities in a situation like this COVID-19 pandemic. It is challenging to have two square meals a day with inadequate pension. Ashray-Akruti team organized grocery kits distribution Program at Kammaguda, Turkayamjal, and provided support for many more Divyangjan along with me.
