society such as transgenders, people with disabilities and those with chronic illnesses have to deal with discrimination and lack of access to systems. This makes it even more difficult for them to earn a decent income and provide themselves and their families with decent nutrition and medical care. Waves of the pandemic that swept through the

nation and the lockdowns imposed have only heightened this struggle. In addition, Covid 19 has led to a global economic slowdown which has lowered incomes and increased prices for daily necessities.

HOW WE ARE HELPING:

At Ashray Akruti, we believe that providing support in a few vital areas will help vulnerable individuals and their families find a path out of poverty.

These areas are food security, daily necessities, health care, education and job training, and support from the community.

Our Covid Relief Service Team has put together a response plan that addresses all these areas. In partnership with our donors, we provide.

Health care support

- Financial assistance to families that have lost their chief wage earner to Covi
 Medical reimbursements for Covid treatment
 - Financial aid to Covid patients and families to cope with medical emergencies
 - that may follow, and financial upheaval due to inability to work
