Opening Doors to Quality Hearing Care with the Support of State Street

We are thrilled to announce the inauguration of a state-of-the-art Free Hearing Clinic in Manikonda, held on May 30, 2024, and generously sponsored by our esteemed partners at State Street. The opening ceremony was graced by distinguished leaders from the State Street team, marking a significant step towards accessible quality healthcare for all. This new clinic is equipped with advanced facilities, including BERA (Brainstem Evoked Response Audiometry) testing, which enables accurate diagnosis of hearing impairments in young children at early stages.



This ensures timely provision of hearing aids and appropriate interventions, particularly benefiting children from underprivileged backgrounds. Thanks to the infrastructural support provided by State Street, the clinic features soundproof testing rooms designed to assess hearing issues across all age groups and to recommend suitable treatments.

Offering these services at no cost, the clinic aims to encourage more individuals to prioritize their hearing health, irrespective of their financial situation, while also raising awareness about hearing loss.

We are deeply grateful to the State Street team for their unwavering support, and we look forward to continuing our partnership in promoting inclusivity and better health outcomes for all.

Celebrating the Success of SSC Batch 2024





With uninterrupted support of dedicated special educators, and undying faith of loving parents, our special students have yet again achieved success in the 2024 SSC Board Exams. With a hundred percent success rate, all 37 students who appeared SSC Board exams have passed with flying colours, among whom Md. Faizan bagged the first position by securing 9.5 GPA, followed by Tabassum and Khaja Faheem Uddin who have scored an impressive 9.0 GPA. Celebrating the hard work and dedication of our achievers, a celebratory gathering was held at the Ashray Akruti office, wishing the students continued success for their future.

Giving new wings to empowerment with WEST

The past quarter saw commendable growth of our women empowerment initiative with 18 WEST trainees out of the total 25 students of the previous batch being placed in various NGOs, schools and companies, paving the way for financial security and independence. With training in Indian sign language, computer operation, financial education, two-wheeler driving and soft skills, the trainees are prepared by experienced professionals to enter the employment sector with confidence. A new batch of Women Empowerment through Sign Language and Technology (WEST) program has commenced in the month of June with the generous support of our partners at Unisys, marching on the path of empowerment of women from underprivileged backgrounds by providing them training in Indian Sign Language, basics of computer education, English language speaking skills, two-wheeler driving and a myriad of soft skills like ppt, email and resume preparation, making them enabled to enter the employment sector with confidence.





Starting the Legacy of Inclusivity with ISL Training



Becoming a part of this initiative, our partners at State Street and Dell took training in the basics of Indian Sign Language from the experienced and certified sign language interpreters of Ashray Akruti over the course of 10 weeks, expanding their teams' horizon of inclusivity.

After the completion of the course 88 members of the State Street team and 94 members of the Dell team received certification marking the initiation of a legacy of inclusivity. As a part of our mission of creating a world-space where persons with disabilities are provided equal opportunities beyond the restrictions of their abilities, we come up with initiatives that create awareness on and work towards bridging the gap between disabled and non-disabled population.

Our ISL training program is a step towards achieving this aim by partnering with eager corporates who share the commitment of making a difference.



Progressing on the path of Awareness with SLEIP

The previous quarter has been especially eventful in the journey of our SLEIP team. Dedicated to the creation of awareness for the usage of sign language in bridging the communication gap between the hearing and non-hearing, the Sign Language in Education Institutional Program (SLEIP) intends to promote the cause of inclusivity among the common masses through educational institutions. In the past quarter, the SLEIP team has performed the national anthem in sign language interpretation in 4 schools namely; Goutham Model, Chipotle high school, Blue Bells high school, and Government high school, reaching at a total of 310 beneficiaries who gained exposure to the usage of sign language.

With an intent to increase corporate sensitization regarding the disability of hearing-loss and the benefits of sign language as an effective medium of communication, the SLEIP team has performed the national anthem in sign language interpretation in corporate events creating awareness that has reached over 2300 beneficiaries. Further bearing the flag of awareness high, the SLEIP team has provided sign language training to teachers at speed school in BHEL, creating an empowering and inclusive environment for students with hearing disabilities. We are extremely thrilled by the progress of this initiative and hopeful for the continued success in future as well with the support of our gracious partners.

Reaching new milestones in inclusivity with the My Sign Challenge (MSC)





An innovative approach in creating an world-space for people with inclusive disabilities through the creation of awareness, the My Sign Challenge is an incredible initiative applying the approachability of social media for a social cause. The social media initiative intends to familiarize the general public with the use of sign language by throwing simple and fun challenges of interpreting commonly used word and phrases into Indian Sign Language and then passing the challenge on to their friends and followers. The support of our amazing partners at various corporates have resulted in the ascending success of this initiative and have helped us in reaching new milestones with each passing day. In the past quarter, the My Sign Challenge initiative has reached Kwadi gouda Satva Necklace mall, Dhullpally T.S. Forest Academy, Ashoka One Mall, GSM Mall and Microsoft Company, creating 160 more informative participatory videos reaching at hundreds of audiences through our social media handle and carrying the cause of awareness even further.
